Here are some of the things we have been actively doing :

- car charging points installed in our hotel car park
- use 100% renewable electricity through Energia in the hotel
- support and inform guests of the principles of Leave No Trace – click [here](#) for more information
- upgraded gas boilers in our lodges to more efficient ones

- encourage our guests to stay longer by running stay for longer for less offers
- contribute to the local economy by maintaining and supporting local employment
- dedicated wild flower garden at the hotel
- monitor our gas, waste, water and electricity usage on a monthly basis
- implement a reduce, reuse, recycle and repair policy
- build local both experiences and touches into our guest experience which celebrates the locality
- have a considered approach to sourcing material - during our recent renovations we used recycled flooring, sourced antiques giving them a new life, our bar and bar counter are reclaimed
- use local suppliers for our furnishings and fittings, engage local contractors to complete the works
- supporting local food and beverage producers and design our menus with this in mind
- working with local artists to showcase their work, our retail area is stocked with wonderful local products
- reduction of single use plastic, using refillable where possible
- use refillable toiletries across the Fiddle + Bow Collection
- our toilet paper is PEFC certified toilet paper
- hand dryers are sensor operated in the public toilets
- encourage our guests to dispose of waste correctly through our signage and providing bins for general, recyclable and food waste
- our hotel rooms - bathrobes are available on request, we have a towel reuse programme, use refillable glass bottles for water and refillable coffee canisters
- our Russells breakfast - we incorporate refillable jars for yogurts, fruit, cereals and our hot breakfast is cooked to order
- take away containers are compostable and recyclable where possible, no plastic straws in the bar
- reusable keep cups for sale in our retail area
- use refillable eco label cleaning products as much as possible
- used kitchen oil is collected at the same time new oil is delivered
- our lighting is LED and our exterior lighting is on a timer

- our back of house/worksaces have censored lighting
- use paperless HR processes
- accounts department use online account software and invoices are uploaded here reducing paper
- have a policy of responsible printing, only printing when necessary and using recycled paper
- our guest correspondence is electronic, encourage customers in the bar to avail of email receipts
- support and sponsor local sports clubs and local events with contributions and vouchers
